**Total - \$2200**

**Tuition** covers full participation in all activities during the festival. These activities include, and are not limited to, private lessons, chamber coachings, public performances, master classes, and possible solo opportunities (based on audition).

**Room and Board** fees cover all housing costs, three meals per day and all transportation during the festival. Transportation to and from the festival is not covered by PCMF, however airport transportation to and from Redding, CA and/or Medford, OR airports is available.
